NEW PRESCHOOL MID-DAY LOADING

Preschool loading and unloading at mid-day, whether it be by bus or parent escort, will take place in the Elementary's front main-entrance parking lot. (Previously, it was conducted in the north-side, bus parking lot.) Due to safety concerns, this new procedure will help youngsters stay closer to the building, remain on the sidewalk, and keep transportation procedures consistent. When parents transport a preschooler, they will pick their child up (morning session) and/or drop their child off (afternoon session) at the school's main entrance where they will exchange their child with school personnel.
